Entries need to be delivered to the Elwood Elementary gym, located on the northeast side entrance at North J and 19th Street, on Thursday August 17 between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Entries must be picked up at the Elwood Elementary, Sunday, August 20, between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Entries left after 4:00 p.m. will be taken to the Chamber of Commerce on Tuesday.
