Rules

- The parade will start at 10:00 a.m., Saturday, August 15.
- Parade check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. at the Dollar General Store parking lot.
- All parade units must check in prior to the parade and should be in their designated/assigned space no later than 9:30 a.m.
- The parade will travel north on Anderson Street turning east on North K Street (by Harvest Market) and ends in the high school parking lot.
- Parade entries must be received no later than Friday, August 7.
- Parade handouts are encouraged and permitted. However, they **MUST NOT BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES**. Parade walkers are welcome to hand out items and candy.
- No squirt guns are allowed. • All horses will be placed at the back of the parade route (for obvious reasons).
- The judges' stand will be at the intersection of Main & Anderson Streets. Winners will be contacted via phone number provided on entry form and will be announced from the Chamber of Commerce tent throughout the day on Saturday, August 16. Awards can be picked up at the Chamber tent or the Chamber of Commerce Office following the Glass Festival.
